[...] 6. PROHIBITED USES

6.1 Neither the Licensee nor Authorised users may:

- 6.1.1 remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Materials:
- 6.1.2 systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Licensed Materials, including complete issues, for any purpose:

6.2 The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:

13. INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORIES

13.1 Publisher hereby acknowledges that the Licensee may from time to time wish to post in an Institutional Repository the revised text version of an author's 'postprint' of the article (i.e. the article in the form accepted for publication in a Publisher journal following the process of peer review). Publisher hereby grants Licensee permission to do this during the term of this Agreement, provided that:

- 13.1.1 Licensee or any other person may not make the article available for commercial sale or for any systematic external distribution by a third party (for example a listserv or database connected to a public access server); and
- 13.1.2 the final Publisher PDF version of the article is not used; and
- 13.1.3 an embargo of 12 months is applied after first publication (be it in online or print) of the article in STM (science, technology and medicine) subjects and the behavioural sciences, and of 18 months after first publication for SSH (social science, arts and humanities) journal articles; and
- 13.1.4 any amendments or deletions or warnings relating to the article issued or published by the Publisher are included; and

13.1.5 Licensee has where necessary also obtained the prior consent of any author or person holding a copyright interest in the article Licensee wishes to include in such Institutional Repository; and

13.1.6 the following acknowledgement is included:

"This is an Author's Accepted Manuscript of an article published in [include the complete citation information for the final version of the article as published in the [JOURNAL TITLE] [date of publication] [copyright Taylor & Francis], available online at: [http://www.tandfonline.com/\[Article DOI\]](http://www.tandfonline.com/[Article DOI])."

13.2 Licensee acknowledges that the provisions of Clause 13.1 relate solely to articles in journals published by the Publisher and are without prejudice to any rights granted or retained by an author and/or the Publisher in any author or contributor agreement between these parties (an "Author Agreement") and that in the event of conflict or dispute between this Agreement and any Author Agreement, the provisions of any such Author Agreement shall take precedence.

SCHEDULE 4

Permitted Use and Authorised User Restrictions

1.1 The following definition shall apply for this section and the rest of the Agreement:

"Authorised User" means the individuals listed as authorised users of FID Romanistik [...]

1.2 In relation to the Licensed Materials to which Licensee has subscribed:

- (a) it may display the Licensed Materials electronically to the Authorised Users via access to the Online Services;
- (b) solely for use by the Authorised Users in the ordinary (internal) course of Licensee's business it may:
 - (i) download and store limited and insubstantial extracts of Licensed Materials in machine readable form;
 - (ii) print one copy of any articles, reports and newsletters contained in the Licensed Materials for each Authorised User; and
 - (iii) print limited and insubstantial extracts of the Licensed Materials,

provided that such printing and storing shall not amount to the copying of a substantial part of any of the Products in which such reports, newsletter, journals or extracts are contained;

- (c) Licensee may allow the Authorised Users to use limited and insubstantial extracts from the Licensed Materials in internal business reports circulated to its employees or officers provided it does not form part of a systematic, regular or routine pattern of use;
